

RECOGNITION OF YOUR PROFESSIONAL OR VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATION IN GERMANY

Would you like to live and work in Germany? And are you looking for a job in an area where you already hold a qualification from your home country? Then you need to check whether your professional or vocational qualifications are recognised in Germany and whether you need an official Certificate of Recognition. Official recognition is required for certain occupations (e.g. doctor, teacher or nurse), and in any event it can improve your chances in the German job market.

🗣️ If you don't speak German, it's a good idea to get help from someone who can guide you through the procedure.
